



2020 Point Leo Swim Classic Q&As

Q - Will Point Leo SLSC be managing an organised physical swim event on Boxing Day this year at Point Leo beach?

A - No – Point Leo SLSC will not be organising any physical Swim Classic on Point Leo Beach this year due to Government and Life Saving Victoria COVID restrictions.

Q – What is the Point Leo ‘Virtual’ Swim Classic?

A - The Point Leo ‘Virtual’ Swim Classic is where competitors complete the set distance for a swim or run at any location and then lodge a valid time electronically.

Q – How many events will be available?

A – There will be the opportunity to register for multiple events:

- 1.2km Point Leo Swim Classic
 - The Balnarring and District Community Bank 2.5km Swim Challenge
 - 400m Nipper swim
 - 400m Novice swim
 - 4km Honeysuckle run

Q – How do you register for any of the Point Leo SLSC Swim Classic events?

A – The registration process has not changed from last year. A registration link will appear on the Point Leo SLSC website.

Q – When are the dates and times for registration?

A – All Swim registrations open from 12:01am ESDT December 4, 2020 and close 4:59pm ESDT January 4, 2021.

Q – When can I complete my virtual swim/run

A – Swim/run race period is 10 days only. 12:01am ESDT 26 Dec 2020 – 11:59pm ESDT 4 Jan 2021. All swims/runs are required to be completed and lodged within this time period. Your dedicated registration link will only be available during this time.



Q – Are there race categories this year?

A – Age categories are consistent for all swim and run distances -

- a. 8-9 years
 - b. 10-11 years
 - c. 12-13 years
 - d. 14-15years
 - e. 16-17 years
 - f. 18-19 years
 - g. From 20 years – there are 5-year divisions

Q – How do I calculate my event age category?

A – Age taken at 26 December 2020

Q – What is the cost of registration?

A - \$10 allows entry to any event and you can enter as many events as you like. There is an additional cost for an event T-shirt.

Q – What does my registration include?

A – Registration fee includes the option to enter all events and a record of swim/run rankings relevant to swim/run event and age category.

There is an additional option to purchase a Limited-Edition Swim Classic T-shirt (at an additional cost).

All registrations go in the draw for spot prizes, kindly donated by our Sponsors.

All spot prize winners will be listed on the Point Leo website.

Q – How do I receive my limited-edition 2020 Swim Classic T-Shirt?

A – All Swim Classic t-shirts will be mailed out (via Australia Post) after the swim closes in January.

Q – What are the event rules?

- Swimmers must be 12 years or older on the 26 December 2020 to compete in the Point Leo ‘Virtual’ Swim Classic events (excluding the 400 metre Nipper swim).
- Only those swimmers who have trained and feel competent to complete the event distance should enter the ‘Virtual’ events.
- All events are to be undertaken as one continuous swim/run.
- You can only submit times that are within the minimum and maximum time and distances a maximum of twice per day.
- If you are submitting a manual time it’s optional to upload a photo of your watch face or your workout from your preferred personal performance tracker.
- We expect all participants taking part to be honest when entering their times. This is not a competition for prizes and is about participation.



- Point Leo SLSC may from time to time review submissions and may take action if and as required should it deem to be necessary.

Q – How do I record my swim/run time?

All entrants will be emailed a link to enter their race time soon after entering. Time data can be manually entered, GPX data (from a garmin or other supported watch) can be uploaded or added in Strava. All times must be entered between the specified swim/run period to be eligible for validity and entered into the random prize draws.

Q – How do I lodge my time?

All entrants will be emailed a dedicated link to enter their race time. Your competitive time must be undertaken between the specified swim/run period with times officially lodged prior to 11:59pm ESDT January 4 to be eligible for validity and entry into the random prize draws.

Q – Will results be available to view?

A – Yes, you can see your results uploaded in your swim & age category when you use your registration link.

The results will also be available on the Multisport Australia website and via a link on the Point Leo website.

Q – Are any group entries available?

A – No, only individual swims/runs and individual registrations are available.

Q – Can I enter any events if I live interstate or OS?

A – Absolutely! However, if you order a t-shirt, we will need to recalculate the cost of postage for interstate and OS destinations.

Q – Can I enter results for different events on the same day?

A – Yes you can.

Q- Are any winners deleared for the swim and run events this year?

A – No winners or placegetters will be delared this year. However there will be spot prizes given in each swim/run event, thanks to our sponsor – Bluegum.



Q – How do I enter the Point Leo Swim Classic ‘Virtually There’ Instagram competition?

A – Simply email swimclassic@pointleoslsc.com.au a great photo of yourself taken during or soon after completing your event.

If your photo is chosen and posted on our Point Leo SLSC Instagram page during the 10 days of the swim, you will win either a free Point Leo Turkish towel or a Point Leo dry pack - that will be posted to you.
